Discover Kraków with us – Poland's historical capital, full of royal splendor and academic spirit! Strolling through the charming streets of the Old Town, we will visit Wawel Hill, where Polish monarchs were crowned, the Main Market Square with the majestic St. Mary's Basilica, and Collegium Maius – the cradle of one of Europe's oldest universities. This is a city where history meets modernity, and culture fills every corner.

ITINERARY:

10:00 Meeting with an English-speaking guide at the Barbican: introduction to Kraków's history and its medieval fortifications

Walking the Royal Route: along Floriańska Street to the Main Market Square, stopping at:

- St. Mary's Basilica (exterior)
- Cloth Hall
- Town Hall Tower

Short visit to Collegium Maius courtyard – history of Kraków's universities and their famous students Continuing along the Royal Route: Grodzka Street and the first Baroque church in Kraków (St. Peter and Paul's Church - exterior), Kanonicza Street

Walking up to Wawel Hill: Wawel Cathedral (exterior) and the Arcaded Courtyard – history and legends of the Hill

14:00 Descent to the Dragon's Den and tour conclusion at one of Kraków's legendary landmarks
